

Spring and Fall Clean Up

All clean up items must be placed within 6ft of the road by 7am on the Monday of your collection week. Each household, including apartment buildings of three units or less, are eligible for spring cleanup collection. The maximum weight of individuals cannot exceed 50lbs or one cubic meter in size, with the exception of furniture and appliances. The total amount to be set out should not exceed 650lbs.



What's In

- Appliances (one of each type)
 - Box Springs and Mattresses
 - Lawn Furniture
 - Tools
 - Broken Glass (safely packaged)
 - Furniture
 - Hot Water Tanks
 - Toys
 - Bagged Garbage
- **Small amount** of home improvement material (ie: carpet cut at three foot lengths, a sink, a toilet, a door)



What's Out

- Construction, Renovation, Demolition Waste
- Commercial Waste*
- Electronics –TV's, Computers, Printers
- Car Parts
- Liquids
- Tires
- Hazardous Waste, Propane Tanks, Batteries
- Leaf & Yard Waste
- Recyclables and Organics

NOTE: *Commercial waste includes apartments over three units, farms, businesses and institutions.
