**Downtown street closure on September 16<sup>th</sup> in the afternoon**

**Truro** – In parallel to the One Horse Town live music show (taking place at the Civic Square on Friday, Sept 16<sup>th</sup>), the Town of Truro has also been working with the Nook&Cranny brew pub to coordinate a Block Party on Prince St, in anticipation of the large crowds drawn into the downtown. The Town has therefore decided to close portions of several downtown streets, so that everyone can enjoy these events in a safe way:

**From 1:00pm to midnight**

- Prince St will be closed to traffic, between Pleasant St and Louise St.

Local residents on Pleasant St (between Prince & Duke) will be encouraged to access their homes from Prince St.

**From 4:00pm to midnight**

- Public parking between Louise St and Prince St will be closed for access at 4pm and egress at 6pm. Anyone wanting to leave this parking after 5:30pm should use the Alley at the back of the Marigold Centre.
- Louise St will be closed to circulation, except for local traffic.
- The intersection between Pleasant and Duke St will be closed to circulation, except for local traffic.
- The intersection between Arlington and Muir St will be closed as well, except for local traffic.
- The intersection between Prince and Arlington St will be closed to circulation.
- The intersection between Prince and Young St will be closed to circulation.
- The intersection between Prince and Forrester St will be closed to circulation.
- The intersection between Forrester and Victoria St will be closed as well, except for local traffic.
