**Travel restrictions lifted for mainland Nova Scotia:
Victoria Park trails are reopened**

Truro – Restrictions on travel and activities within the woods have been lifted by Nova Scotia Fire, for all of the Province, as of August 17th.

The Town of Truro is therefore re-opening the Victoria Park trails to the public. People are still asked to continue to avoid any activity that could potentially cause more brushfires.

Campfire and brush burning in the province is now permitted as of today, in every county, from 2pm until 8 a.m. The latest information on burning restrictions is posted daily at 2 p.m. on <http://www.novascotia.ca/burnsafe>
