Fire jugglers coming to downtown Truro!

Truro – Fire performers and daredevils will take over downtown Truro on Saturday evening. The third event in a series of summer street parties on Inglis Place, "Shredfest" is sure to attract all ages. While many stores and restaurants will remain open, Inglis Place will be closed to vehicle traffic so a series of ramps can be placed to demonstrate bike and skateboard stunts. Local retailers HAF Skate and Tattoo and Bike Monkey are providing the ramps.

If that's not enough of a draw for thrill-seekers, event organizers have also hired Halifax fire performance troupe Incendia Motus. The team of three performers will light up Inglis Place with fire breathing, juggling, and acrobatics. *"We're excited to bring together some unusual entertainment to this event,"* said coordinator of special events and culture Sam Madore. *"It's a great way for people to make the connection to downtown Truro on a summer Saturday night."*
