Town of Truro Seeking Input on Biking throughout Truro

Let's connect...to further Truro's Bikeability.

The Town of Truro is seeking resident's opinions about biking throughout Truro.

Physical interactive maps have been placed in key, high traffic locations throughout town. The Town is asking residents to visit one of the four locations and provide their input on such things as destinations, routes, barriers/safety concerns, etc.

Residents are able to drop into any of the four locations listed below, during their individual business hours, to view the maps and offer feedback. The four locations are:

- Bike Monkey, 130 Esplanade Street
- Hub Cycle, 33 Inglis Place
- Millbrook Band Office (through Physical Activity Coordinator, Gordon Pictou), 820 Willow Street
- Douglas St. Recreation Centre, 40 Douglas Street

The maps will be available for public input until February 11th. After this time, the information will be collected and used to inform an action plan for biking throughout Truro. It will help to further the Town's efforts to connect cycling routes throughout Town and outlying areas. The Town is also looking at infrastructure requirements to make biking throughout town more convenient and desirable for residents and visitors.
